

## ANWICU Trainees Prize Entry Requirements

The entry should be in the form of an abstract and should be the authors own work. It should be submitted on or before the dead-line date. Permission for submission should be gained from all co-authors.

The abstract should be submitted in MS Word, Apple Pages or PDF format and should be no more than one side of A4 in length, inclusive of tables, diagrams and references. Minimum font size 12 with single line spacing.

The layout should be in the form of Title, Authors (with the presenting author highlighted in bold, along with their email address for correspondence), Introduction, Methods, Results, Conclusions and References. Tables and figures should be appropriately annotated and placed below the main body of the text.

Following the closing date, the abstracts will be assessed according to the specific criteria for each prize, given elsewhere. The lead author of each submission will then be informed and, if successful, asked to present.

Presentations will usually be limited to 9 minutes with 3 minutes for questions. Acceptable formats include MS Powerpoint, Apple Keynotes, Prezi or PDFs. If required, authors may use their own lap-tops or other device. Please remember to bring appropriate VGA dongles and try to arrive in time to test your presentation prior to the meeting commencing.

The judges will assess the presentation according to the criteria and marking scheme given elsewhere and award the prize(s) accordingly.
